Kutná Hora, the home of Hph Ltd, the manufacturers of the 'Shark' is a small Czechian town 60 kilometres from Prague with a population of just 21,800.

The local residents are extremely proud of their association with aviation and especially with the small sailplane development company headed by Jaroslav Potmesil.

During the middle ages, profits from the Kutná Hora silver mines brought fame to the lands of the Czech Crown, and Kutná Hora was the richest and most powerful town in the Czech lands and at the turn of the 14th and 15th centuries, Kutná Hora became the seat of King Václav IV.

Today the town survives on tourism and small bouquet companies like HpH Ltd, who are starting to make their presence felt in the gliding world, more especially with their 304 M Shark and the new 20 metre twin two seater which is still in its developmental stage but expected to first fly early in 2012.
